- Get on M1 State route 26
- Exit at Airport Link/Airport link M5 continue on M7, M2 and Warrego Hwy to Mount Crosby Rd/State Route 37
- Take the exit for Mt Crosby Rd/State Route 37 from Warrego Hwy/M2
- Merge onto Mount Crosby Rd/State Route 37
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Mount Crosby Rd/State Route 37
- Turn left onto Allawah Rd
- Continue onto Lansdowne Way
- Turn right onto Allawah Rd
- Turn right Restricted-usage road Scout Camp. Use caution steep decent

These directions are for planning purposes only.

You may find that construction projects, traffic, weather, or other events may cause conditions to differ from the map results, and you should plan your route accordingly.




