Ideally located on a protected stretch of the Tweed River featuring a salt water lagoon.

 - Follow M1 and Pacific Mwy to Kennedy Dr in Tweed Heads, follow signs for Tweed Heads (1HR 17MINS)
 - At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Kennedy Dr
 - Use the right lane to take the slip road to Tweed Heads S/Banora Point
 - Continue onto Minjungbal Dr
 - Merge onto Wharf St
- Turn right onto Dry Dock Rd

These directions are for planning purposes only. You may find that construction projects, traffic, weather, or other events may cause conditions to differ from the map results, and you should plan your route accordingly. You must obey all signs or notices regarding your route.

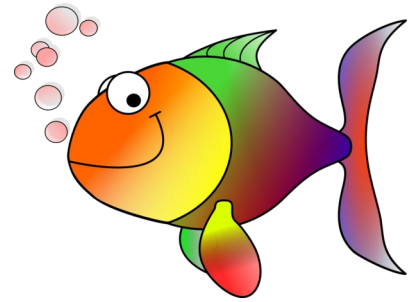
EMERGENCY DETAILS -FIRE OR MEDICAL

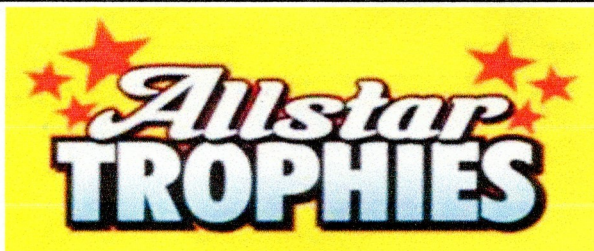

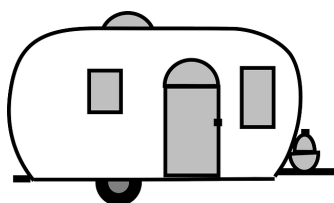

My first task is to get the Activities Roster ready for the 2020 year. This will hopefully be passed at the November Committee meeting.

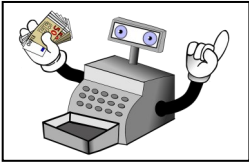
