- Follow M1 to Old Bruce Hwy. Take exit 244 from M1 (102 klms)
- Continue on Old Bruce Hwy. Turn left onto Kenilworth Skyring Creek Rd.
- Turn right onto Tuchekoi Rd
- Turn left onto Mary Valley Rd/State Route 51 Turn right onto Brooloo Rd ,continue on to Imbil Island Rd in Imbil (21.3klms)

These directions are for planning purposes only. You may find that construction projects, traffic, weather, or other events may cause conditions to differ from the map results, and you should plan your route accordingly.

You must obey all signs or notices regarding your route.




Ten vans were in attendance with 'cosy' couples Rod and Gayle and Brian and Loretta sharing a cabin. Three couples made the day trip on Saturday.



To all club members who aren't felling the best or are about to enter hospital or recovering from an illness I can assure you all that all the club members wish you a speedy recovery.




