Directions: 1 h 9 min (72.3 km) via M1 and Steve Irwin Way

"These directions are for planning purposes only. You may find that construction projects, traffic, weather or other events may cause conditions to differ from the map results, and you should plan your route accordingly. You must obey all signs or notices regarding your route"

- Follow Anzac Ave/State Route26/State Route 71 to M1
- Turn right to merge onto M1
- Take the exit towards Steve Irwin Way
- Keep left at the fork and merge onto Steve Irwin Way
- Merge onto Steve Irwin Way
- Turn left onto Railway St
- Railway St turns left and becomes Maleny St
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Maleny St
- Continue onto Landsborough Maleny Rd
- Continue onto Bunya St
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Coral St
- Turn left onto Coral St/Maleny Stanley River Rd
- Turn into showgrounds Maleny Showground, 13 Maleny Stanley River Rd, Maleny QLD



Maleny Showgrounds offers camping year-round. Groups and caravanning clubs are welcome.

Facilities: Showers/Toilets, Electricity, Water, and Dump Point (**new**). **Payment by cash only \$25 per night**: Includes electricity, water, toilet/shower facilities, access to Dump Point.

"Nearby attractions include Obi Boardwalk (0.6 km), Maleny Chocolate Factory (0.9 km), and Sweets On Maple (0.9 km). The top attractions to visit in Maleny are:

Maleny Botanic Gardens & Bird World, Mary Cairncross Scenic Reserve, Maleny Dairies, Gardners Falls and McCarthy's Lookout.



What a great Weekend for everyone coming out of Covid 19 Hibernation.


A big thank you to those who braved the chilly wet weather. Monday was the sunniest day. Lots of catching up and chatting with everyone staying apart in 2 groups.
