- Follow State Route 50 towards Mudgeeraba Rd
- Turn into Mudgeeraba showgrounds 115 Mudgeeraba Rd, Worongary QLD
  4213



#### Activity Report - Maleny Showgrounds

The activity for July was a game of Boules organised by Evon and Graham with help from Noel Weeks and Rick and Helen Roeder. Registration commenced at 2.30pm. A total of 27 members registered to play.

Two courts were marked out on the grass just inside the main rink of the showgrounds and it was great to be out in the sun together having a fun game. Thanks to Eric who supplied the cord and rope that was used to mark out the courts.

In order to keep the game Covid 19 safe, participants were reminded of social distancing & hand sanitiser and wipes were also available for members to use. The boules were cleaned with antiseptic wipes before each new round. Noel and Graham were kept busy clearing each court before the next round.

Evon explained the one main rule of holding the boule with your palm facing down so that the boule was sitting downwards towards the grass. No underarm bowling was allowed instead the boule was to be thrown out and along the court with enough force to land close to the jack. The jack was to remain in a fixed position on the court so that everybody had an equal throwing distance.

Three players were called up for each court and each player was given two boules. A round consisted of each player taking turns to throw their two boules at the jack. The player who got closest to the jack was awarded one point and winner of that round. Evon and Helen Roeder were the score keepers.

The first round was a practice round which allowed everybody to try out their skills and get a feel for throwing and the weight of the boules. The winners of each round from both courts went through to the next round after all the boules and been collected and cleaned.


