Directions: 1 hr 32 min (131.4 km) Via M1

- From Hornibrook Esplanade/State Route 27
- Continue straight onto Houghton Hwy/State Route 26/State Route 27
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for M1 and merge onto M1
- Follow M1 and Pacific Mwy to Tugun Currumbin Rd in Currumbin. Take 95 from Pacific Mwy/M1
- Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Gold Coast Hwy/State Route 2. Use the 2nd from the left lane to continue on Coolangatta Rd
- Use the right lane to stay on Coolangatta Rd
- Turn right onto Charlotte St. You have reached your destination.


REMINDERS


