**<u>DIRECTIONS</u>**: Follow Bruce Highway (M1) North to Caboolture. Take the D'Aguilar Highway, go through Wamuran, Kilcoy, then on to Blackbutt. At the War Memorial in town, turn right to the Showgrounds. Go to the **RIGHT** of the building (**it will be signed**)

European settlement in the Blackbutt area began in 1842, when the Scott family established Taromeo station. In 1887, the Scott family ceded land to found both Blackbutt and its neighbouring town of Benarkin. Farms were established in the area and the discovery of gold in the area in the late 19th century led to population growth in the town. Blackbutt Provisional School opened on 20 January 1896 under teacher Rosa Bella Ryan. In 1909 it became Blackbutt State School. In January 1914, the school relocated to a larger site. Blackbutt Post Office opened by November 1906 (a receiving office had been open from 1896). The Blackbutt War Memorial was unveiled on 24 April 1920 by J.A. Lee, the chairman of Nanango Shire.
