Next Month's Rally - Bigriggen Bush Camping Park Wednesday 17th to Monday 22nd March 2010

Bigriggen is set on 100 acres on hilltops & river flats, surrounded by National Parks, bordered by the Logan River & Burnett Creek. You can explore the Scenic Rim, nearby dam, swimming, fishing, bush walks etc

This will be bush camping – There will be **NO POWER & only tank** Water- you will need to bring your own container, plus drinking water. Amenities are above average with Hot & Cold showers. Hot water is <u>20 cents coin operated</u>. Ample toilets (Septic System) Kiosk - open 8am to 6pm, camp fires (if no fire ban) Sorry no dogs allowed. Generators are allowed but require Hosts approval. <u>No Eftpos or credit</u> <u>Facilities</u>. Well grassed with shade trees. You may require levellers.

Cost: \$7.00 per Adult per night. Guests register at Kiosk on arrival.

The Rally co-ordinator will require your Booking by Fri. 5th March 2010. Please note you <u>do</u> need to advise Peter if you <u>will or will not</u> be attending the rally, thank you.


Carriers: Eric Byng, Peter Crowe, Kevin Keary, John Mackenzie (Stock) If you are not attending please arrange an alternate carrier ASAP.

Directions: (145 Klms from Redcliffe to Rathdowney) Travel over the Gateway Bridge & onto the Gateway Motor way. When you reach the intersection, with the Pacific Motorway it is advisable to move over into the right lane, as this lane runs into the left lane of the Gateway Motorway which continues on until it joins the Logan Motor way. Travel to-wards Ipswich, for about 2 klms. Then take the slip road on the left, & join the Mt Lindsay Highway, until you reach Beaudesert. Turn right at the traffic lights, continue onto Rathdowney. You drive through Rathdowney then take the first turn right after the school into Boonah/Rathdowney Road, after travelling 7 klms turn left into upper Logan Road approx. 600 mtrs turn right into Bigriggen Road, 2 klms of very good gravel road to park. Please note the road in, through private property is a public road and as such, all road rules must be obeyed. Speed Limit 40 klms. For those who travel through Brisbane. Travel over the Story Bridge, Through Woolloongabba on to Moorooka, Join the Mt Lindsay Hwy there until you reach Beaudesert, then on to Rathdowney

Tyre & Wheel Information

"All members are reminded that they should have their wheels on their vans balanced. An unbalanced wheel puts extra strain onto the vans bearings. Also you should be rotating your tyres by including the spare so all get similar usage. This can assist in prolonging the life span of the tyres. Lastly you should cover your exposed tyres (old piece of fibro is excellent) to the sun when the van is in storage. Many tyre failures are a consequence (over time) of not being protected whilst sitting at home waiting for the next trip."



C heck Handbrake

Check for rust or corrosion where base plate fixes to A frame. Hand brake lever should move freely. Check condition of brake cable and pulleys.

Hence we all like to keep them in top working condition, however our power lead and water hoses are the most vulnerable as a consequence of their application (running some distance from our van). Members and their guests attending our rally venues are expected to respect others property and in particular <u>never</u> drive over the abovementioned two items regardless of the circumstances.



GIVEN ANY THOUGHT TO THIS???

Do you know the load rating of your 'D' shackle that connects your vans safety chain to your tow vehicle??? The shackle must have a load rating equal to or greater than the chain. Simply thinking that your 'D' shackle diameter being the same as your chain is ok is not always correct as it depends on the load rating. In most instances there will be no load rating stamped on the shackle. Also many 'experts' will tell you a galvanised shackle is stronger than a stainless one. Have a look at the below charts and see that this supplier documents that their stainless way outperforms galvanised. These are sold at any Super Cheap store. 12MM diameter is the min you should be using. At least you have documented evidence of the rating of the shackle......
