Kenilworth is a quaint highlands town, in the beautiful upper Mary Valley Country, behind the Blackall Range, in the Sunshine Coast hinterland. It is about one and a half hours drive north of Brisbane. The town is on the Mary River which flows north from Maleny. Enjoy the mountain air, the country hospitality and the expansive views along the edge of the escarpment on the way there.

Kenilworth retains its 1930's atmosphere and, for the visitor, has a surprising amount of interest with a very engaging historical museum and a good range of eateries, shops, art gallery and a cheese, yoghurt and **ice-cream** factory.

When visiting Kenilworth from the south, a good plan is to go up there via Maleny and come back via Eumundi. The Maleny route is steeper and can be demanding on the brakes if you are descending while towing a van.

Of course, it's your decision.

TREASURER'S REPORT


Another good rally at a very nice venue.
