#### This is a report I received from Neil & Faye Bremner...

In late January and early February, Faye and I drove down to Newcastle for a short visit to see our daughter and her husband. There was much merriment, overindulgence in drinking and fine wines and .... Ooops, no that was not the reason for our visit and not the essence of our story now..... Caravan parks and places to stay on the way.

On this occasion we did the trip without our caravan as we actually stayed with Helen and Scott. However, we'll mention later a couple of choices for 'parks' near Newcastle (if you're interested). Of particular interest to Faye and me when driving down was the number of caravans on the road. It was still late January and there were a few 'vans' of the tourist type coming and going. Later, into the second week of February, the increase of the 'retiree movement' of touring rigs was clearly evident. The grey power hibernation period was at an end and again we were taking our share of the tourist routes.

If your travels take you to the Newcastle part of the map and you would be looking to park the van, (as we did on the occasion of Helen's wedding in 2006) the 'park' across the Hunter River opposite the city, the Council park at Stockton Beach, was found to be popular and recommended. A good ferry service is provided to the City. There is another at Tomago, which is just off the Pacific Highway on the northern approach to the City. Again we found it OK and particularly good for storing the van for a couple of days.

On our return trip to Brisbane we broke the trip by staying overnight at Coffs Harbour. There is any number of resort' style accommodations on the northern approaches to Coffs. We stayed at the Aqua Luna and for the extra \$20 this was far superior to the old 1950's style motels in the town.

As we are always on the lookout for parks to check out, we headed for Iluka. This place is off the main highway, quiet, yet has all the 'mod' facilities of a regular town, various styles of accommodation, offers fishing, and ocean and river views. Iluka is on the northern side of the Clarence River and opposite Yamba. If you want the brighter lights, then go to Yamba by all means, but for the quiet relaxing week away from it all there are a couple of 'parks' to chose from.

#### The Council runs the ILUKA "RIVERSIDE" TOURIST and CARAVAN PARK

And National Parks and Wildlife operates **Woody Head Camping Area**. The latter requires self sufficient stays as there are no powered sites. We reckon it would be heaven to try it for a few days - a real 'get away from it all' experience. There's spacious van sites, adequate facilities, kiosk, both calm water and surf swimming and fishing.

The Riverside Tourist Park is more the conventional caravan park. It is situated on the river with many sites facing onto the river front. These river facing sites were \$25 night. Facilities are generous with many barbeques and shelters. It is closer and within walking distance to the township which has everything to offer.

Unfortunately we did not take any photos, but we've tried a couple of scans from brochures.

Lastly, we'd mention that it is pleasing to see the increasing number of rest stops now appearing on the Pacific Highway and the continuing improvements to the Highway itself.
