Slight L onto Sunshine M'way (70).

Exit onto Sunshine M'way (70) towards Maroochydore/Noosa Heads.

Exit Mooloolaba Road towards Alexandra Headlands/Buderim.

Keep R @ fork, follow signs to Mooloolaba Road.

Slight R onto Sugar Road.

At Roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Maud Street.

L onto Aerodrome Road/State Route 6.

1st R onto First Avenue.

3rd R onto The Esplanade.

Continue onto Cotton Tree Parade and Cotton tree Holiday Park.

Things to do: ... Bike riding for the energetic ones. Fishing in the Maroochy River. Shopping at Sunshine Plaza (go girls!) Swimming Pool nextdoor. Watch the sun set over the Maroochy River. Eumundi Markets.

5 Minute Chocolate Mug Cake

you'll need

- 4 Tablespoons cake flour
- 4 Tablespoons sugar
- 2 Tablespoons cocoa
- 1 Egg
- 3 Tablespoons milk
- 3 Tablespoons oil
- 3 Tablespoons chocolate drops (optional)
- 1 Mus

here's what you do....

Add dry ingredients to the mug, and mix well.

Crack an egg and add it to your mug. Be sure to mix it well to avoid any pockets of flour in the corners.

Pour in the milk and oil and mix well.

Add the chocolate drops if you've got them, and a splash of vanilla essence too.

Pop your mug into the microwave & zap for 3 minutes on maximum power (1000watt).

Wait until the cake stops rising, and sets in the mug.

If necessary, run a knife around the sides of the mug, and tip the still warm cake out of the mug and onto a saucer.

Sit back and enjoy with a coffee - you deserve it!
