The park is a friendly quiet place 4 km south from the centre of town and is Pet friendly.

**Amenities-** Caravan sites and self-contained cabins, large swimming pool, games room, laundry, BBQ, ensuites and some cement slabs. Also powered camp sites & Camp oven cooking facilities Internet access. Recreation Hall will be available for our stay.

**Power** – Powered Sites & town water. **Cost -\$20.00** if more than 6 vans attend (normally \$26.00)

*Things to do-* Bushwalking, Scenic Drives, Camp Fires, Kangaroos, Wallabies, Birdlife. *Nearby -*Airport, Bowling Club, National Park, Restraurants/Cafes/Bars, shops.

*Requirements*-Normal Hoses & Leads, levelers.
