MARSHMALLOW SLICE All royalties to be forwarded to Vicki MacKenzie's offshore bank account John need not know **Ingredients;** * 250g Sweet Biscuits, crushed * 3/4 cup(35g) Mini Marshmallows or big ones chopped up * 3/4 cup(60g) Desiccated Coconut * 3/4 cup Milk Choc Bits * 1teaspoon Baking Cocoa * 395g can Sweetened Condensed Milk * 100g Butter, chopped * 1 teaspoon Vanilla Essence * 200g Milk or Dark Cooking Chocolate block, melted Method; 1. Grease & Line an 18x28 cm lamination pan with baking paper. In a large bowl **combine** biscuits, marshmallows, coconut, Choc bits & cocoa, Reserve 2. In a medium saucepan combine condensed milk, butter & vanilla essence. Stir over a low heat until butter is melted, making sure mixture does not boil. **Pour** over biscuits mixture, **mix** well & **firmly press** into prepared pan. Refrigerate for 1 hour or until set. 3. Once slice is cooled, spread melted cooking chocolate over the top, refrigerate until set. Cut into squares. **Preparation Time ; 20 mins Refrigerate Time** for 1 hour until set Makes 16 or more. Quantity; Have a good weekend Cheers,



PCCI Reporters' Job Descriptions

- a **cheerful** "non-official" **honesty** about the success or otherwise of a particular Rally it's venue, the facilities, the weather, mishaps and the non-organised activities that occurred.
- a **light-hearted tone** so that different member **"voices" or styles** be heard so as to break the monotony of one style permeating the publication from month-to-month.

However, *more and more* members have joined - and the club has gotten bigger, and will get bigger - and there will be a turnover of members.

There is now a need for newer members, who have volunteered/been press-ganged to report for an issue to be given some guidelines so that they know what they need to cover. (The Acting Editor has gone back over the last 3 years' issues and recorded who have contributed reports - so that they are not "flogged" repeatedly).

By-and-Large the Duties are:-

ROVING REPORTER:-

O Summarises the Day-To-Day Events/ Conditions of the Rally By:-

- Asking People who arrived *earlier* what went on (spontaneous tag-along; group visits to pubs & clubs) notes; weather events; difficulties; pleasant surprises- and taking for your report
- o Observing events from the moment Roving Reporter arrives until her/his departure use spies
- O Report On and Name any Visitors

• Report On Any Inductions

ACTIVITIES REPORTER:-

- Report on the nature of the **Organised Activities**
 - Description of the Activity(ies)
 - The **organisers** and acknowledgement of their efforts and ingenuity as many of them may be doing this for the first time
 - o The degree of involvement and intensity of members in the activities
 - o Humorous events (without embarrassing the participants) occurring during Activities
- O Report on Birthdays and Anniversaries Ceremonies
- Report on the **Raffles** winners

GOSSIP LINE REPORTER:

- The Reporters have been signing off with their *own names* lately (once, they were allegedly anonymous) however either approach is OK.
- The **Gossip Line** reports on accidents, mishaps and quirky events during the rally. The tone must be gently humorous.
- O <u>No Names</u> are reported just the event.

All Reporters should note the Club Rules about the newsletter:-

"To maintain and protect the integrity of the club, the newsletter editor must ensure that each edition contains no contentious, malicious, defamatory, profanity or sexually improper commentary from any source."

It Does Not Matter if the Roving Reporter, Activity Reporter, President, Secretary, Treasurer or Rally Co-ordinator happen to **double-up** / **overlap** on certain topics in their reports.
