Next Month's Rally-Woodford Show Grounds; April 14th to April 19th 2010

Woodford is a small but pretty town, 20 minutes west of Caboolture on the D'Aguilar Highway., it was one of the earliest settled areas of the shire and its history is reflected in several tourist spots. The Australian Narrow Gauge Railway Museum Society has developed a museum off Archer Street and on Sundays, volunteers run a restored steam loco through the town for visitors to enjoy. The summit of Mount Mee offers panoramic views over the Caboolture Shire to Moreton Bay. At the Storeybrook Herb and Cottage display gardens at Petersen Road Woodford, visitors can enjoy homemade Devonshire teas and a stroll through the gardens. Also the town's colonial shops offer a variety of goods from antiques, fashion, home wares and eateries & roadside stalls with produce fresh from the farm. There is a Bowls Club, Golf Club and Swimming pool. The Showgrounds will have plenty of power <u>but</u> limited water outlets, so we will have to 'piggy back' from van to van, level sites, amenities which were rated between good and fair.

Directions from Redcliffe via Deception Bay road where it joins the Bruce Highway near Burpengary Continue on the Bruce Highway, staying in the left lane until you reach the Bribie & Kilcoy Exit. Make sure that you take the lane that the road sign indicates to go to Kilcoy. After leaving the Bruce Hwy at this intersection from the left lane, take the right of the two lanes that pass under the bridge, this is the lane that takes you on to the <u>D'Aguilar Hwy</u>, through Wamuran & on to Woodford. After passing through the main town of Woodford, look for Neurum Road that goes to Villeneuve, It probably has a sign that indicates Show Grounds A short distance along this road, look for the Showgrounds on your right.



Check Safety Chain

Should have no visible signs of rust or cracks at fixing point and should be long enough to reach towbar chain hook and allow for cornering.

C heck Water Tank

Check hoses for leaks, kinks, signs of wear. Check hoses for any mildew growth in hose (black hoses should be used). Check clamps for tension. Check tank straps for signs of cracking or rust. Stone guard if fitted should be checked for dents which may rub a hole in tank

BIGRIGGEN RALLY VAN PARKING DIRECTIONS

Travel along the dirt road through dairy farm, taking care at the two cattle grids. Grid at entry to venue has hump so care is needed to ensure rear of your van does not catch. Stop at the office to register, then proceed through gate as seen in photo #1 below



Once through gate, travel on the right hand path for aprox. 20 mtrs and then turn right just after first gum tree. Turning at gum tree gives space for van to turn. You will see the post and rail fence to your right and it is along here that we believe is the best parking for our rally. Aprox. 50 mtrs ahead and slightly to the right is a fire pit and flat ground. Photo # 2 below shows what you will be looking at after you turn at gum tree.



You can see the road that you came into the venue on, to the right and outside the fence. The flat area that we are talking about is adjacent to that big green bushy tree along the fence. There are 2 of these trees set apart from each other. Back van up to the fence. Park to one side to allow others to fit in. The Amenities are to the left of the photo, about a 40 mtrs walk.
