There are a couple of ways to get to Crows Nest:

1. Via Toowoomba

Follow the Warrego highway Route 54 up the Toowoomba Range, then turn right onto the New England Highway Route 85 and follow for about 50 K's to Crows Nest.

2. Via Esk

Follow the D'Aguliar Highway Route 85 for 26 K's past Kilcoy then turn left to Esk on the Brisbane Valley Highway route 17. At Esk turn right and follow for 49 K's to Hampton turn right and Crows Nest is 12 K's ahead.

It is less of a pull going via Kilcoy and Esk than going via Toowoomba. Please take care even in the cooler months as your car can boil when going up the range if you are trying to get to the top to quickly.
