


# Newsletter MAY 2009

<u>Next Month's Rally-Murwillumbah NSW</u> Wed 17<sup>th</sup> to Mon 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2009







*Location-* 488 Tweed Valley Way, Murwillumbah...1.5km South of Railway Station, 28km south of Tweed Heads/Coolangatta, 45 minutes from Surfers Paradise and the Gold Coast.

*Requirements-* normal hoses & leads.

*Amenities-* Pool, Modern amenities block, BBQ area, Ensuite cabins, Caravan sites & Tent sites. Convenience shop at Park & bottle gas available. (Re Cabins- linen supplied for double bed only) **Pets allowed** strictly at Park Managers discretion, usual rules apply.

Power & Water- Powered sites to fit all size vans and water.

*Things to do-* There is a Golf Course, Bowling Club & Services Club, Tropical Fruit World and Research Park, Madura Tea Estate Tour (Requires booking), Mt.Warning, Lamington National Park, fishing in the Tweed River. Revisit Nimbin, Crystal Palace & Lismore.

Cost per van per night- Normally \$25.00 for the club rally \$23.00

# BANANA BREAD (Serves 8) Cooking time less than 60 minute- will keep well, wrapped in foil in the fridge.

# **INGREDIENTS**

- 2 bananas
- 2 tablespoons golden syrup
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 cup S R flour
  - pinch of salt

# **METHOD**

Heat oven to 180 degrees. Grease and line base of loaf pan Mash bananas then add golden syrup, add sugar and stir, add egg, S R flour and salt Then mix to combine. Pour into loaf pan and cook approx 30 mins - test with skewer to see if cooked when skewer is withdrawn dry.

#### **Check Water Tank**

Check hoses for leaks, kinks, signs of wear. Check hoses for any mildew growth in hose (black hoses should be used.) Check clamps for tension. Check tank straps for signs of cracking or rust. Stoneguard if fitted should be checked for dents which may rub a hole in tank.
