
# Peninsula caravan club inc

#### This is a Helpful Hint I read in the Harvey Bay Clubs newsletter and thought it worth repeating here.

For those of you that are away travelling, I just heard a great tip. It's called the one cup tip. You put a cup of water in your home freezer. Freeze it solid and then put a 20c coin on top of it and leave it in your freezer. That way when you come back after a trip, you can tell if the power went out for a time while you were away. If the coin has fallen to the bottom of the cup that means all the food defrosted and you should throw it out. But if the coin is on the top then all is well. If the coin is in the middle then your food may still be ok, but if in doubt - just throw it out.
