It has recommended that members have a Personal medical record form, which is available from a chemist, displayed in your RV to assist Ambulance staff etc. in case of an emergency.

This information should include any Medical Conditions, medications & ICE contact/s.

This information can also be stored in your smart phone for those times you are out & about.

To access the Medical Information section on your smart phone navigate to your Contacts List & locate **Your** name at the top then **Select** it. This may need to be done through **Settings** on some phones.

Your details will now be displayed select **Edit** to start updating then scroll down until you locate Edit Medical ID (IPhone) or Medical Info (Android) or like then **Select**.

Now complete any appropriate sections e.g. Medical Conditions, Medical Notes (Medications), Blood Type & ICE (In Case of Emergency) contact/s then select **Done** or like to save

This information can then be accessed if required by selecting **Emergency** from your Passcode screen. No passcode is required.




REMINDERS

Members are reminded that the PCCI Constitution and By-Laws can be located on the club website under the Members Only - Club Documents section.


