I have been asked to include this recipe from Jill into the newsletter, It was very tasty at Dickys.

Happy Hour Snack.

One High Tin Bread Loaf, with nice crusty top.

Fillina

1 tin drained corn kernels (440g)

1 tin creamed corn (440g)

Few shallots or Spring onions, roughly chopped

4 bacon rashers

1 to 1 ½ cups grated pizza mix cheese

1 cup sour cream

Ground black pepper

Dash of paprika (optional)

Chop bacon into small chunks, fry in saucepan till cooked, stir in shallots, cook for couple of minutes,

Cool slightly

Add remaining ingredients, stir well, adjust seasoning, add more cheese or cream but don't let it be too soggy,

Cut the "lid" off the bread by slicing about 2" down careful not to cut the bread case itself.

Remove the "Bread" from inside the loaf and place loaf on pizza tray.

Warm filling then place in bread cavity, pop in mod oven for 30 minutes: meanwhile tear up the removed bread and lid into bite sized bits then place around the loaf for the last 15 minutes.

To eat, dip crusty bread bits into filling, as the filling goes down use sides of the bread loaf to scoop out the filling.

A very hearty snack, perfect with drinkies.
