Driving Directions:

From waypoint on Steve Irwin Way turn west into Kilcoy-Beerwah Road at the lights. Cross over the railway line and proceed to the roundabout. Turn **right** at the roundabout into Simpson Street.

The entrance road to Beerwah Sports Ground is just up the road from the roundabout on the right-hand side in Simpson Street, opposite Aldi. After turning into the entrance street (sign says Sportsground), continue south under the overhead road to the sportsground.

All the painting masters assembled in the meeting hall to decide the grand masters in painting.


A little interruption before we started with one of our creative masters taken to hospital in an ambo, (reports are he is ok, so a speedy recovery Jim). Now down to the competition.



Wash moving parts on your stabilizing jacks in a mixture of diesel and kerosene mixed about 50:50. This helps to prevent your jacks from seizing up and leaves a thin layer of lube on the parts that won't collect dust and dirt. Accumulation of dust can actually impair their function, so look after them.


