Two holiday destinations in one. There is direct access to the Maroochy River and the stunning Maroochydore Beach.

Maroochy River is an angler's delight with great fishing all year round.

Enjoy a riverside barbecue with family and friends on one of the BBQs whilst watching the sun set over the Maroochy River with over eight hectares of manicured beach and riverfront land there is a spacious and shady place for everyone.

**Facilities** at the park include:

372 powered tourist caravan sites (24 absolute waterfront), 29 un-powered tent sites 9 Deluxe Villas and a four bedroom Beach House

BBQs, 5 amenity buildings, 3 laundry facilities, with coin operated washing machines and driers.

LPG and party ice, bait for sale, free Wi-Fi, Scooters are now permitted to be ridden in the internal roads, subject to our park rules being observed. This includes wearing a helmet, 8kph speed limit and daylight hours only.

**Check-in/Check-out**

Front reception teams are working hard to make additional flexible options for check in/out. They are encouraging guests to take up the option of finalising payments in advance over the phone and receive their boom gate, site number and amenities codes remotely.

## Directions: 1 hr 10 min (80 km) Via M1

- Get on M1 in Deception Bay from Klinger Rd & State Route 26 21 min (14.9 km)
- Follow M1 and Sunshine Motorway to Sugar Rd in Buderim. Take the exit towards Alexandra Hd from Sunshine Motorway/State Route 70 40 min (62.2 km)
- Continue on Sugar Rd. Take Centenary Cres, Wrigley St and Fourth Ave to King St in Maroochydore.

These directions are for planning purposes only. You may find that construction projects, traffic, weather or other events may cause conditions to differ from the map results, and you should plan your route

You must obey all signs or notices regarding your route.

## THINGS TO DO

- Swimming, surfing, playing on the patrolled Maroochydore Beach or banks of the Maroochy River
- Visit the Maroochydore Surf Club, or Maroochydore RSL for a delicious meal and great atmosphere, nice selection of restaurants
- Swim in the Cotton Tree aquatic centre located next door, shop at Sunshine Plaza Shopping Centre
- Lawn bowls – the Maroochydore Beach Bowls Club is located only 100 metres from the holiday park entrance
- Visit Australia Zoo. Noosa National Park, Sea Life Sunshine Coast Aquarium, Tandem Skydiving.

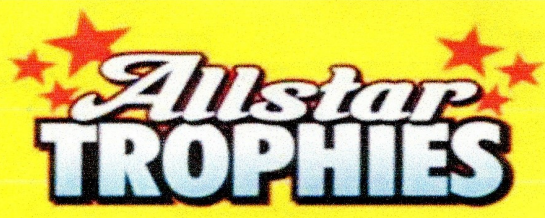

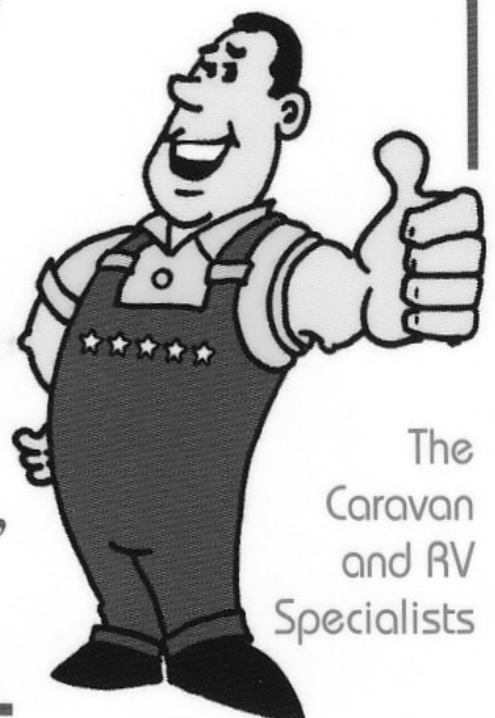

## EMERGENCY DETAILS - FIRE OR MEDICAL

To seek urgent help, continual quick short blasts of a whistle or car horn (3 seconds on/off).

Upon hearing this members are requested to proceed in an orderly manner to the site of the whistle or car horn bringing with them mobile phone, fire extinguisher, water bucket, fire blanket, torch and first aid kit where available.

It has recommended that members have a Emergency booklet, which is available from most chemist, displayed in your RV to assist Ambulance staff etc. in case of an emergency. This information should include any Medical Conditions, medications & ICE contact/s.

This information can also be stored in your smart phone for those times you are out & about.
