Nestled in the foothills of the Lamington National Park lies the delightful township of Canungra Queensland. Known as the 'Valley of the Owls', Canungra owes its existence to the early cedar getters and sawmillers and in the early part of the 20th century was home to the largest softwood timber mill in Australia.

A developing business hub, the town is well known for its surrounding tourism offerings and is well supported by visitors year-round. Close to town, tourists can enjoy farm stays, bed and breakfasts, cabin accommodation and vineyards.

Many visitors also stop at Canungra en route to the Lamington National Park and the mountain resorts of Binna Burra and O'Reilly's.

Situated on the Beaudesert-Nerang Road, near the picturesque Canungra Creek, Canungra has become the main service centre for the south-eastern part of the Scenic Rim region. It serves a community of more than 1200 people, plus military personnel from the nearby Kokoda Barracks. Canungra is also home to a burgeoning wine industry and state-of-the-art equine facilities.

Community facilities include a primary school, post office, ambulance, police, rural and auxiliary fire brigades, doctors, chemists, dentists, veterinary surgery, service stations, garages, TAB, hardware store, baker, butcher, electrical stores, hairdressers, supermarket, newsagent, video shop, real estate agent, RSL, laundromat and café.

Moriarty Park is a popular sporting ground which is used by junior and senior soccer, rugby league and cricket clubs. Hang gliding, pony club, lawn bowls and swimming are the other main sports enjoyed by the community.

#### Directions: 1 hr 31 min (111 km Via M1)

- Take the M1 south and take exit 38 & take 4th exit at roundabout to Stapylton Jacobs Well Rd (69.2 km)
- Take Stanmore Rd to Beaudesert Beenleigh Rd/State Route 92 in Wolffdene 8 min (7.4 km)
- Follow Beaudesert Beenleigh Rd/State Route 92 to State Route 90 into Canungra
- Off the Beaudesert-Nerang Road turn into Coburg Road the Show Grounds are on the Right

These directions are for planning purposes only. You may find that construction projects, traffic, weather or other events may cause conditions to differ from the map results, and you should plan your route. You must obey all signs or notices regarding your route.



#### **Constitution & By-Laws**

Members are reminded of the following Constitution section 12 relating to Election of Management Committee.

- 12. (1) A member of the management committee may only be elected as follows: -
  - (a) to serve as a member of the management committee, a member of the association (the 'candidate') may be nominated by one member of the association (the 'nominator'), and seconded by another member of the association (the 'seconder').
  - (b) the nomination must be: -
    - (i) in writing; and
    - (ii) signed by the candidate and the members who nominated and seconded him or her; and
    - (iii) given to the secretary at least **30 days** before the annual general meeting at which the election is to be held;
  - (c) each member present at the annual general meeting may vote for any number of candidates not more than the number of vacancies;
  - (d) if, at the start of the meeting, there are no nominations for a specific position, nominations may only then be taken from the floor of the meeting for that position.
  - (2) A list of candidates names in alphabetical order, with the names of the members who nominated each candidate, must be publicised in the association newsletter prior to the meeting and also be in a conspicuous place at the meeting of the association immediately preceding the annual general meeting.
  - (3) If required balloting lists must be prepared containing the names of the candidates in alphabetical order.
  - (4) If there are 2 or more nominations for a position elections will be by secret ballot; and
    - (a) the chairman will call for at least 2 scrutineers.

To seek urgent help, continual quick short blasts of a whistle or car horn (3 seconds on/off).

Upon hearing this members are requested to proceed in an orderly manner to the site of the whistle or car horn bringing with them mobile phone, fire extinguisher, water bucket, fire blanket, torch and first aid kit where available.

It has recommended that members have a Emergency booklet, which is available from most chemist, displayed in your RV to assist Ambulance staff etc. in case of an emergency. This information should include any Medical Conditions, medications & ICE contact/s.


