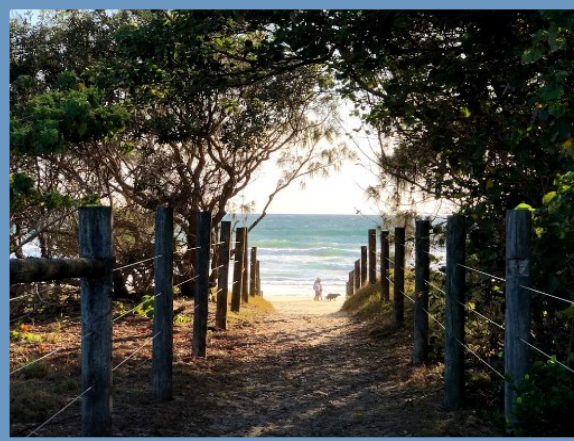

Coolum Beach is undoubtedly the quintessential Australian surf beach and what better way to enjoy it than staying on absolute beach frontage at the Coolum Beach Holiday Park. Sites with direct access to the patrolled surf of Coolum Beach make this park one of the Sunshine Coast's most popular camping and caravan destinations.

Located next to the Surf Club, Coolum Beach Holiday Park is set on ten acres of pristine beachfront land. Wander along the soft white sand and listen to the sounds of the waves or find a shady spot to relax and unwind under the Pandanus trees and Casuarinas. The park is in easy walking distance to shops and restaurants, as well as the Surf Club and the Coolum Beach Bowls.

Stroll along the headland boardwalk, cycle along the designated bike paths, take your pick of two nearby golf courses or walk to the top of Mt Coolum and take in the spectacular views across the Sunshine Coast. There is plenty of excitement for everyone.



Rally Coordinators Report for Coolum Beach Holiday Park continued...

Coolum Beach Holiday Park also **accepts dogs on application**. Please peruse the Dog Friendly - Conditions of Acceptance document for your information and consideration prior to making an application.

Things to do near the caravan park:

- swimming / walking / fishing / relaxing at the Coolum Beach patrolled beach
- lawn bowls – Coolum Beach Bowls club only 50 metres from the entrance
- walk to the top of Mt Coolum and see the spectacular views across the Sunshine Coast
- bingo Tuesday and Thursday mornings at the Coolum Surf Club
- restaurants / cafes / clubs – including The Coffee Club and McDonalds across the road, Coolum Surf Club next door plus Coolum Beach Bowls Club nearby.

How to get there:

Get on M1 from Anzac Ave/State Route 71 and State Route 26
Continue onto Deception Bay Rd
Turn right to merge onto M1



Continue on M1. Take Sunshine Motorway/State Route 70 to Emu Mountain Rd in Peregian Springs
Take exit 194 for Sunshine Motorway towards Mooloolaba
Keep right at the fork to continue towards Sunshine Motorway
Continue onto Sunshine Motorway
Continue onto Sunshine Motorway/State Route 70
Take the State Route 70/Sunshine Mwy exit towards Maroochydore/Noosa Heads
Continue onto Sunshine Motorway/State Route 70
At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Sunshine Motorway/State Route 70 heading to Noosa Heads
Take David Low Way/State Route 6 to Peregian Esplanade in Peregian Beach
At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Emu Mountain Rd heading to Peregian Bch/David Low Way
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto David Low Way/State Route 6
Turn right onto Peregian Esplanade

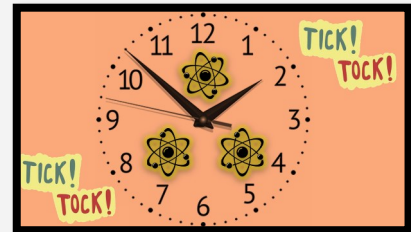

EMERGENCY DETAILS - MEDICAL

To seek urgent help, continual quick short blasts of a whistle or car horn (3 seconds on/off).

Upon hearing this members are requested to proceed in an orderly manner to the site of the whistle or car horn bringing with them mobile phone, fire extinguisher, water bucket, fire blanket, torch and first aid kit where available.

It has recommended that members have a Emergency booklet, which is available from most chemist, displayed in your RV to assist Ambulance staff etc. in case of an emergency. This information should include any Medical Conditions, medications & ICE contact/s.

This information can also be stored in your smart phone for those times you are out & about.

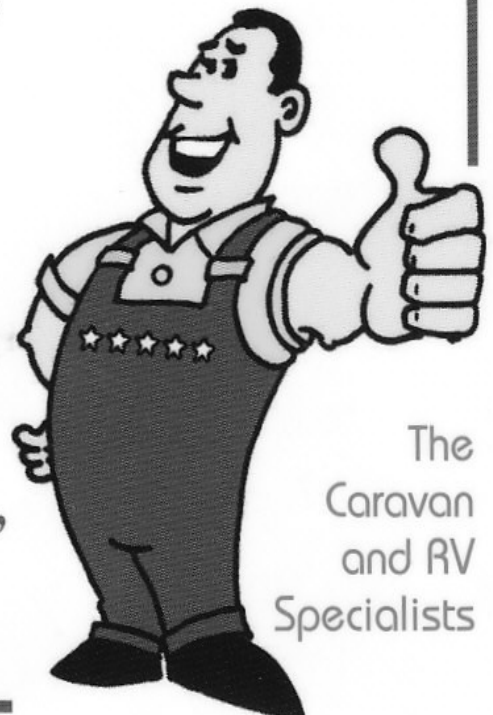
