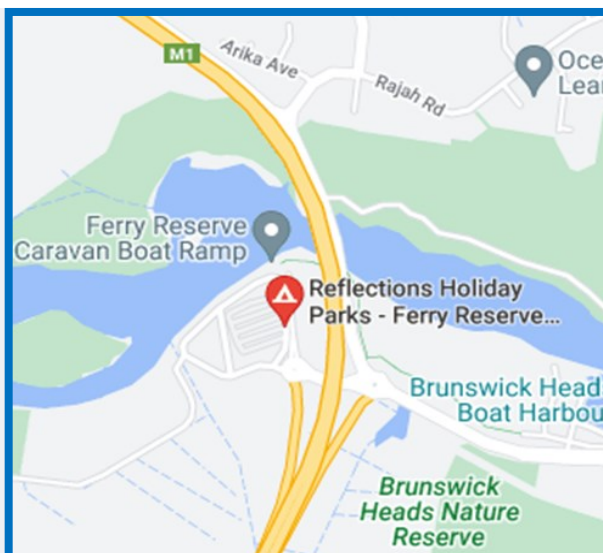

Reflections Ferry Reserve Holiday Park

15–22 February 2023

Location:

Ferry Reserve is on the doorstep of the beautiful Brunswick River and has the magnificent Mt Warning as its backdrop. Named after its location, it is the site of the first ferry to cross the river. This park is a safe and accessible place for swimming, snorkelling and kayaking. Because it has its own boat ramp - the only park in this area to do so - it is the obvious choice for the committed fisherman or boater. Brunswick Heads is 151 kms from Brisbane.



Directions:

Take the M1 and head south to the Gold Coast and stay on this road to Ocean Shores turn off on your left 175 kms. Stay on Brunswick Valley Way heading south until you cross over the Brunswick River. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit, stay on this road for about 200 metres and the caravan park will be directly in front of you. If you miss this turn off look for the next off ramp on your left head for Brunswick Heads stay on Tweed Street and eventually you will come to a roundabout, take the 2nd exit and in 200 metres the caravan park will be directly in front of you.

Reminder to book Ferry Reserve, Brunswick Heads if you are coming to February's rally

Things to do at the rally:

Fishing from river banks, wharves, jetties, sea wall and ocean beach and of course your kayaking from in front of the caravan park. The river is usually lousy with bream which will frustrate you no end, try bread under a float rather than fish. Black Fish or Luderick are in good numbers in this river and can be caught on fish baits but best by far is cabbage weed scraped from rocks at low tide.

- Markets every Friday morning at Mullumbimby, a real hippy culture/feel here
- Crystal Castles, a bit different set on beautiful grounds
- Byron Bay itself and the Lighthouse
- Dinner booked for Friday evening at Hotel Brunswick
- Gazebos are required
- Cruise tours from Brunswick Heads

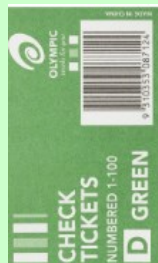

EMERGENCY DETAILS - MEDICAL

To seek urgent help, continual quick short blasts of a whistle or car horn (3 seconds on/off).

Upon hearing this, members are requested to proceed in an orderly manner to the site of the whistle or car horn bringing with them mobile phone, fire extinguisher, water bucket, fire blanket, torch and first aid kit where available.

It has been recommended that members have a Emergency booklet, which is available from most chemist, displayed in your RV to assist Ambulance staff etc. in case of an emergency. This information should include any medical conditions, medications & I.C.E. contact/s.

This information can also be stored in your smart phone for those times you are out & about.
