storm one evening but that did not dampen our spirits.



Constitution & By-Laws

Members are reminded of the section of **PENINSULA CARAVAN CLUB INC. BY-LAWS** regarding:

Attendances

- **28.** Ordinary members or member couples must advise the Secretary/Rally Coordinator directly of their ability to attend a rally at least 10 days prior to the rally.
 - (a) Associate and Social members must request permission from the Secretary/Rally Coordinator to attend a rally at least 10 days prior to the rally, as Ordinary members have priority to attend particularly if a venue has limited sites.
- **29.** Ordinary Members must attend at least four official rallies in a club year (October to September).
 - (a) Where this cannot be achieved, the respective member must advise the secretary in advance or as soon as the absence occurs by emailing the club email account *peninsulacaravanclub@gmail.com*.
 - (b) Failure to do so may cause their ordinary membership to be cancelled.

Visitors

- **30.** Visitors are very welcome at club rallies, however they must:
 - (a) Advise the Secretary/Rally Coordinator at least 10 days prior to the rally; and
 - (b) Attendance must be subject to the availability of site room at the rally
 - (c) (c) A 'visitors details' form is to be completed and submitted to the club Secretary no later than day of arrival but preferably 10 days prior to arriving at the intended rally.
 - (d) (d) Visitors are generally not eligible for any club provided subsidy.

Leave Advice

31. Ordinary Members embarking on an extended time away due to holidays, sickness or other commitments must notify the Secretary in writing of the anticipated period. NOTE: - Full membership will be retained under these circumstances.


Directions to our Christmas Luncheon at the Beach House 185 Bishop Road Beachmere



Members Medical Information

It has been recommended that members have a Personal Medical Record and details displayed in your RV to assist Ambulance staff etc. in case of an emergency.

This information should include any medical conditions, medications and In Case of Emergency (I.C.E.) contact/s.

This information can also be stored in your smart phone for access at any time or any place.

To access the Medical Information section on your smart phone, navigate to your Contacts List and locate Your name then Select it. This may need to be done through Settings on some phones.

Your details will now be displayed. Select **Edit** to start updating then scroll down until you locate **Edit Medical ID** (iPhone) or **Medical Info** (Android) or like then **Select**.

Now complete any appropriate sections e.g., Medical Conditions, Medical Notes (Medications), Blood Type & ICE (In Case of Emergency) contact/s. You will also need to scroll down to Emergency Access (iPhone) & select **Show When Locked**. then select **Done** or like to save.

This information can then be accessed if required by selecting **Emergency** from your Passcode screen. No passcode is required.
